



## MAJOR DANILLO D. BELARMINO

Major Danilo Belarmino serves as the Section Commander, United States Air Force School of Aerospace Medicine (USAFSAM), Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio. He is responsible for maintaining the good order and discipline of 1,000 personnel that drive a diverse research, education, and consultation mission set across 7 geographically separated units. The team fuels operational consultation across the Air Force and trains 5,000 Department of Defense and international students annually. Moreover, Maj Belarmino serves as the Deputy Director, Center for Sustainment of Trauma and Readiness Skills (C-STARS) Dayton. He guides a \$5 million military and civilian partnership as the Air Force's sole dedicated enlisted readiness platform, training medics to work in a critical care environment.

Maj Belarmino commissioned into the United States Air Force Nurse Corps in 2013 as a first lieutenant through direct accession. He has served as an Air Force nurse in clinic, emergency/trauma, and the intensive care. Prior to this, Maj Belarmino served as the Element Leader and Chief of Operations, Emergency Department, 959th Inpatient Operations Squadron, Fort Sam Houston, Texas.

Maj Belarmino is board certified in emergency nursing and maintains qualifications as a member of the Critical Care Air Transport Team (CCAT). He has deployed in support of Operations Enduring Freedom and Resolute Support.
