



CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT CHARLES G. WORTMAN

Chief Master Sergeant Charles G. Wortman is the Command Chief of the 711th Human Performance Wing, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio. He is the principal advisor to the Wing Commander on supporting more than 2,000 tri-service enlisted, officers, and civilians. The Wing is comprised of two technical directorates and ten diverse departments at nine geographically separated units at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base and Joint Base San Antonio-Fort Sam Houston, Texas to include 10 Air Force Specialty Code-awarding courses with a 5,000 annual student throughput.

Chief Wortman entered the Air Force in January 1997 as an Aerospace Medical Services Apprentice and later selected to serve as an Independent Duty Medical Technician. His unique ability to earn trust and build alliances has paved the way to leadership positions in both line and medical units. He has led at the Flight, Squadron and Group to include service as a First Sergeant. He has deployed in support of OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM and OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM and has completed overseas tours in Japan, Germany and the United Kingdom. Prior to assuming his current position, he served as the Chief of Medical Enlisted Forces, AFMED Agency, Office of the Air Force Surgeon General, Falls Church, Virginia.
